### **Virtual meeting:**

#### **Digitisation in the asylum procedure and integrated identity management**

The focus of this meeting is the exchange of experience with using digital tools in the asylum procedure and the promotion of European cooperation in this field.

The meeting will be hosted on the BAMF official event platform.

### **Key topics:**

#### **Digitisation technologies**

The BAMF is a pioneer when it comes to digitalising asylum, and relies on innovative technologies such as blockchain. As part of the Council Presidency, the BAMF aims to push forward European cooperation in digitalisation through coordinating joint European activities.

#### **Name transcription**

In order to align Arabic name spelling methods with one another, a web-based transcription service (TKS) has been developed which transcribes Arabic names into a consistent Latin script. In order to facilitate a higher quality of data in the various migration databases, the BAMF aims to make TKS available to public authorities across Europe.

### **Language recognition**

The BAMF works together with several European countries to plan a pilot project for language and dialect recognition in which the exchange and analysis of speech recordings are tested. The goal is to optimize the identification of the spoken language of applicants.
